PRECAUTIONARY INFORMATION FOR TREATED SEED

Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapor. Do not take alcohol immediately before or after exposure to this product. The consumption of alcohol by the applicator can increase the toxicity of the product. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. This bag contains treated seed. When opening this bag or loading/pouring the treated seeds, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing the eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **If Swallowed:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If Inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or a doctor for further treatment advice.
